
ORDER

Complainant, a federal prisoner, has filed a complaint alleging misconduct by a United States District Judge in Complainant's post-conviction proceedings.

Complainant complains that the judge erroneously denied his pro se motion for leave to file a Rule 60(b) motion because the judge "interpreted the 60(b) motion wrong."

The complaint relates directly to the merits of decisions or procedural rulings and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii). Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process and may not be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
