
ORDER

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed a complaint alleging misconduct by a United States District Judge in Complainant's civil lawsuit.

Without providing any facts in support of the allegations, Complainant appears to allege that the judge conspired with the defendants to hide the court's dismissal order so that Complainant would miss the deadline to appeal and did so for "personal gain of social political or not yet proven financial gain." Complainant—who states that he was a "football prodigy"—further complains that the judge demonstrated "unconscious internalized racism by glorify[ing] [h]is own football success in his distinguished alumni award."

The court finds no support for Complainant's allegations, neither in his complaint nor in the record. These conclusory allegations are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii) as "lacking sufficient evidence to raise an inference that misconduct has occurred."

The complaint is DISMISSED. An unredacted private order is entered simultaneously herewith.
