The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Ivan Villegas has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Villegas has filed a response. We have reviewed counsel's

brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein, as well as Villegas's response. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Villegas's motion for the appointment of counsel is DENIED, as is his alternative request for an extension of time to file a pro se appellate brief. See *United States v. Wagner*, 158 F.3d 901, 902-03 (5th Cir. 1998).
