The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Juan Gabriel Orozco-Barragan has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Orozco-Barragan has filed a response. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Orozco-Barragan's request for the appointment of new counsel in his response is DENIED. *See United States v. Wagner*, 158 F.3d 901, 902-03 (5th Cir. 1998).
